1. Human Ring Toss

- 1 student and 1 teacher volunteer per program

- 2 student volunteers per program
- ★ Players stand at a set distance apart and attempt to throw a mannequin head in a burlap sack at a designated target.

4. Ball Relay

- 2 volunteers per team
- ★ A team of two races to get as many small soccer balls as possible into a designated bucket. No hands allowed!

5. Traditional Field Games: Crab Walk, Sack Race, Egg/Spoon Race

- 4 volunteers per team
